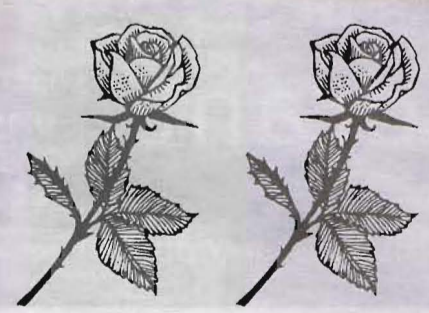

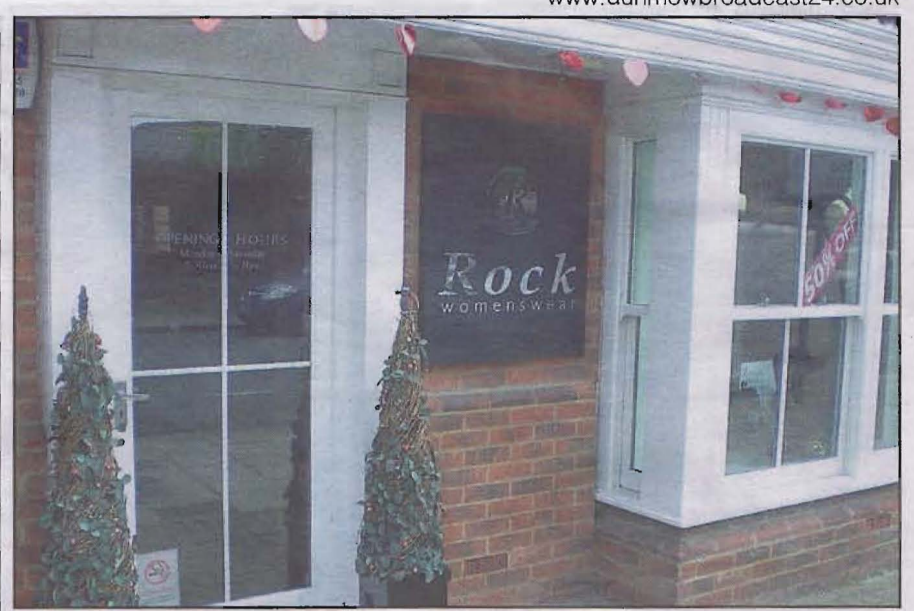

"Coming to Dunmow seemed like a good idea as people from this area were coming to Loughton and saying how good it would be to have a shop like this near them, so that is what I have done."

Mrs Robins said that Rock specialises in offering an extended size-range of designer clothes.

"Whereas most designer clothes don't cater for any size above 14, we also offer brand names in sizes 16 and 18. Basically we offer something for everybody at all different prices and sizes," said Mrs Robins.

Rock stocks clothes from 35 different designers including Paul Smith, Maria Grachvogel, Moschino, Joseph, Sport-Max, Malene Birger, DKNY, Day Birger et Mikkelsen and French Connection.

As well as selling clothes Mrs Robins is very keen to immerse the shop within the community.

"I do a lot of charity work out of the shop in Loughton and I would like to do the same here. I have held various fashion shows and events for a number of children's charities in Loughton. At our last event we raised over £30,000.

"If there are any charities in the local area that would like us to raise money for them, then they can come in to talk to me about it."

Through charity events Mrs Robins feels she has been able to turn her shop into a community by providing a relaxed atmosphere.
